- Institution [address, links]
- Coordinator [affiliation]
- Main funding source [regional, national, EU]
- Geographical scope [local, regional, national, EU-wide]
- Launched in response to [EU directive, other international obligation, national law, scientific interest, management/restoration, other reason ]
- Countries monitored by the schemes
- References

## Scheme descriptors

**scheme**

- What is monitored [list of species/species group, habitat type]
- Aim [population trend, distribution trend, community /ecosystem trend ]
- type of data [presence/absence, counts, mark/recapture]
- sampling design [stratified, random, exhaustive]
- resources [# professionals, # volunteers, time, costs starting/ending year]
- method [transect counts, net trapping, cmr]

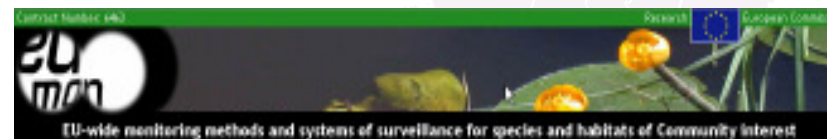
